

BEAR WARNING

LAKE TAHOE IS LOCATED IN A FOREST. BEARS AND OTHER ANIMALS LIVE HERE. WE DO SHARE THE LANDSCAPE WITH THEM BUT WE DO NEED TO REMEMBER SOME SAFE PRACTICES:

1. DO NOT LEAVE COOLERS OR FOOD IN YOUR CAR. THE BEARS WILL FIND A WAY TO ENTER YOUR CAR OR TRUNK NO MATTER WHAT YOU DO.
2. DO NOT LEAVE ANYTHING THAT LOOKS LIKE A COOLER OR FOOD IN OR ABOUT YOUR CAR FOR THE SAME REASON.
3. BEARS HAVE AN EXTRAORDINARY SENSE OF SMELL, EVEN ITEMS IN YOUR UNIT.
4. DO NOT LEAVE YOUR UNIT WITH THE SLIDERS UNLOCKED OR JUST A SCREEN DOOR AT THE ENTRY. YOU MAY END UP ENTERAINING A FURRY VISITOR. BEARS HAVE EXTRAORDINARY CLIMBING ABILITY.
5. IF YOU ENCOUNTER A BEAR, BACK AWAY AND CALL 911.
6. WHILE BEARS REACT ADVERSELY TO LOUD NOISES, A CONFINED BEAR IS A DANGEROUS BEAR.
7. DISCOURAGE BEAR VISITS BY PLACING THE CHAIN ON THE DUMPSTER AFTER USE. BE A GOOD NEIGHBOR, CHECK THE CHAIN FOR PLACEMENT EVERY TIME YOU PASS THE DUMPSTER.
8. DO NOT ALLOW SMALL PETS TO ROAM FREE ON THE EXTERIOR.
9. REMEMBER MORE FREQUENT INTRUSIONS BY BEARS WILL RESULT IN THE DESTRUCTION OF BEARS.
