DON'S CORNER

Carnelian Woods general manager's highlights. The complete report is available in the members section on the website.

- Western Bat did a re-inspection in mid-August and found many units that needed repairs to the bat proofing after the big winter storm damage of 2022/23. Annual on-going cost will be \$5000 for inspection and warranty extension.
- There was a lot of work necessary for the pool, but it opened one week ahead of schedule (June 23)

PERSONNEL CHANGES

Carnelian Woods is going through some staffing changes. Our office staff, Teresa Bertini, resigned on August 1st. A big thank you to our homeowner volunteers, Larry Nowels (Unit 139) and Diane Hopkinson (Unit 26), who are helping with the transition and performing some of the office duties!

Also, our general manager, Don Bemiss, has resigned and his last day will be September. 14th. The board is currenting in the process of advertising and interviewing for a new general manager. Simultaneously the board is also considering bringing in an HOA Management company to run the property in-lieu of a general manager.

POOL/SPA UPDATES

Beginning July 31 the Pool and Spa were open seven days a week. The general manager was able to hire some part time staff to accommodate this.

As the property starts preparation for winter, the pool will be closed after Labor Day, September 4th. The Spas will be open on Fridays and Saturdays only. Please be sure to check the website for the latest pool and spa hours.

BEAR SEASON TIPS

The American Black Bear (Ursus americanus) is active year-round in Tahoe, and the bears have been very aggressive in Tahoe this year, including at Carnelian Woods!

For us in Carnelian Woods, our primary area of concern is the dumpsters.

Here are a few tips to dealing with bears at Carnelian Woods:

- Please be certain that all garbage is placed in the dumpster. Never place trash on the ground or on top, even if the dumpster is full. Please find a nearby dumpster with room for your garbage.
- Ensure that the chain is put on the dumpster to prevent bears from opening the dumpster.
- Don't leave trash, food wrappers, groceries, snacks, or anything with a scent (even toothpaste) in your car. Bears have pried open almost-closed windows and broken in-right here at Carnelian Woods.
- Keep cars locked. Bears are adept at opening all kinds of car doors.
- Keep BBQ grills clean.
- Keed doors and windows closed and locked at night, and when the home is unoccupied.
- Never feed wildlife.



2023 ANNUAL HOMEOWNERS MEETING: SATURDAY OCTOBER 21

WINTER 2022/2023 DAMAGE UPDATES

The board submitted an insurance claim in June for the damages to the property caused by the snow during Winter 2022/2023. The general manager obtained two quotes from construction companies to perform the repair work. Overall the damages are in excess of \$200,000. The insurance company issued an initial check, which was received in August. Unfortunately, both contractors that submitted bids are no longer available to perform the repair work. The GM and the board are in the process of reaching out to additional contractors for the repair work.
